CASEY'S DANCE CENTRE has proven to be an increasingly popular part of the Mill Woods Community. Owned and directed by Marie Casey, a Global Woman Of Vision, the studio offers instruction in **BALLET, JAZZ, LYRICAL, TAP** and **HIPHOP** dance and prides itself in its "people come first" philosophy. Casey's also believes that success in dancing comes from building self-esteem and team work and from developing friendships. Over the years, Casey's has also become very successful in the competitive aspect of dancing with children participating in the Alberta Dance Festival, Standing Ovation and Dance Jam.

Dance instruction is offered to children from the age of three years and up by 14 professionally trained, mature staff. In addition to being members of the Alberta Dance Educators Association, many of the instructors have had specialized training in the fields of education and gymnastics, and have completed courses in anatomy and physiology.

Casey's offers a pre-school program for the young beginner, which gives the child the opportunity to experience the dance forms of tap, jazz and ballet on a weekly rotational basis. These classes are intended to increase concentration, music and coordination skills as well as provide the basis for skills used in later years of dancing.

A selection of recreation classes for students without previous experience are also available. Students receive qualified instruction in the basics of dance and gain experience in stage-work and perform in both a Christmas Show and That's Entertainment, Casey's Year-End show at the Citadel Theatre.

Students also perform in community events, seniors homes and other special events.

Competitive classes are also offered with students entering various competitions through the year. Students are also prepared for RAD ballet exams.

Located in the heart of Mill Woods, Casey's Dance Centre has four large fully equipped studios with raised floors, regulation dance bars and a clean environment.
