## the Spirit of Burnewood Sponsorship Program



Burnewood Community's motto is **"Life is Good in Burnewood"** and it's hard for the majority of us to disagree with this statement. We have great schools, plenty of green space for recreation and a strong community spirit that provides a safe environment for our children to thrive in. There are still some opportunities, however, that are beyond the reach of some of our families. We believe that every child should have the opportunity to have a healthy and active life! To help achieve

this goal, the League has established a Program Sponsorship Initiative called the "Spirit of Burnewood". This initiative will allow children from families who have limited financial resources to participate in sports and recreational activities.

The scope of this program will initially be limited to programs run by the League. These **programs include gymnastics; ballet, hip hop and jazz dance, karate do, art, filmi dance and/or parents and tots**. If the program is successful, it maybe extended to cover Children's programs such as soccer and hockey.

This initiative will provide free registrations in the childrens programs highlighted above. To quality children must be 18 years of age or under and a resident of Burnewood. The child's guardian(s) must also be able to demonstrate that their financial situation is preventing them from registering their child in these types of activities. Asking for help is sometimes hard so our aim is to make the registration process as unintrusive as possible. Burnewood Community League reserves the right to refuse an application without explanation and without recourse.
