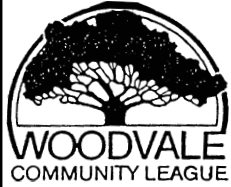

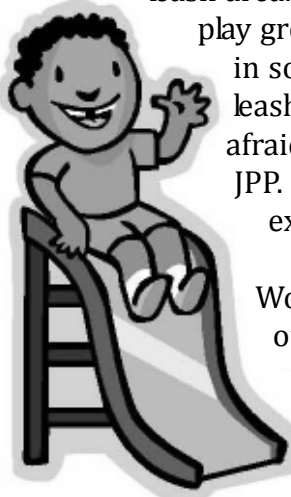
## MESSAGE from the BOARD

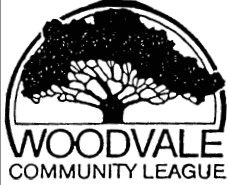

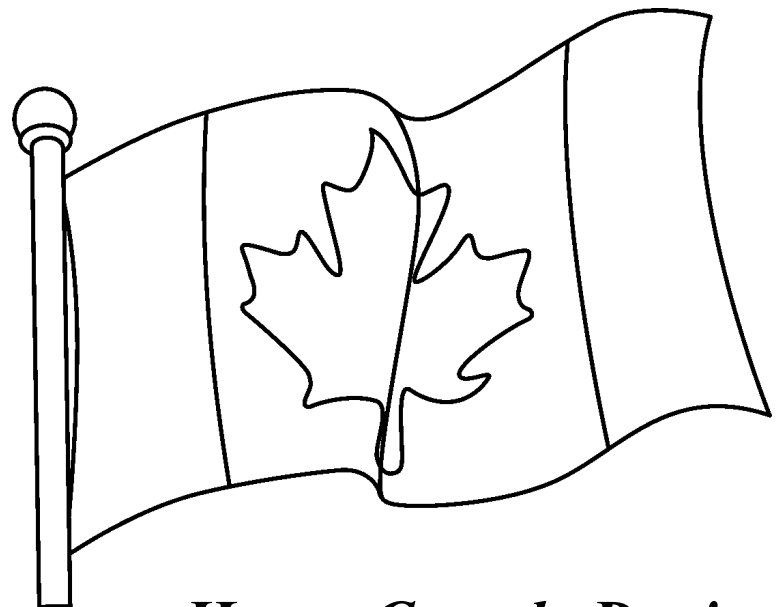
