DID YOU KNOW.....



YOUR GUIDE TO BICYCLE EQUIPMENT LAWS IN EDMONTON HELMETS

All cyclist 17 years and younger are required by law to wear an approved helmet.
 A properly fitted helmet:

- Sits level from front to back of head and about one inch above your eye-brows.
- Fits snugly.

BICYCLES

Bicycles must have:

- A bell
- Brakes that work
- White headlamp in front and red tail lamp and reflect if riding at night

IT IS THE LAW TO:

- Obey all traffic signs and signals
- Yield to pedestrians
- Ride single file on roads
- Ring your bell when passing on pathways and trails
- One person per bike
- Use lights at night
- Keep your bicycle in good repair
